Dear Governor Hobbs, President Peterson, and Speaker Toma:

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-562, the Economic Estimates Commission is submitting its second estimate of total personal income for fiscal year 2023/24 and providing the estimated maximum amount available for legislative appropriations from state revenues for the fiscal year imposed by Article IX, Section 17 of the Arizona Constitution.

The Commission's second estimate of Arizona personal income for fiscal year 2023/24 is \$439.7 billion, a 4.1% increase over the revised fiscal year 2022/23 estimate of \$422.4 billion. Correspondingly, the estimated per capita personal income for fiscal year 2023/24 is \$58,165, a 2.73% change over the revised fiscal year 2022/23 of \$56,621.

Based on this estimate, the maximum amount available for legislative appropriations from state revenues for fiscal year 2023/24 is \$32.6 billion. The limitation is calculated using the current appropriation limit percentage of 7.41% as the multiplier against personal income.
