### Remote Sellers Joint LTN/TPN

- The Department released a draft notice on the treatment of luxury products for TPT purposes.
- Any remote seller of tobacco products (i.e. those without physical presence in Arizona) are subject to the same economic nexus threshold (i.e. \$100,000) as any other remote seller into Arizona.
- Vape and CBD are also subject to the same threshold.
- As a reminder, if you have physical presence in Arizona, you are not considered a remote seller and the economic nexus threshold will not apply.

## Inventory Letters

The Department is aware certain distributors are having issues with beginning inventory not matching ending inventories on monthly filings.

Please note the beginning inventory of the month should always match the prior reported month's ending inventory.

Affected distributors should have received a notice and need to work with the Department on amending the impacted returns. Please note this only affects limited distributors and disregard this message if you have not received a letter.

Below is an example of a return (May 2022 return) obtaining / matching all its beginning inventories from its April 2022 return ending inventories.

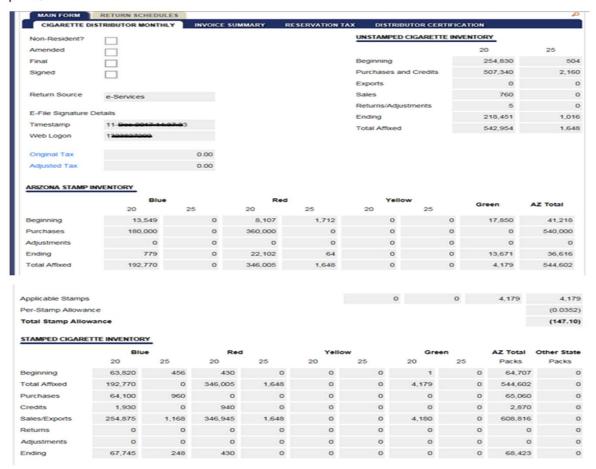
The three inventories to be matched up are:

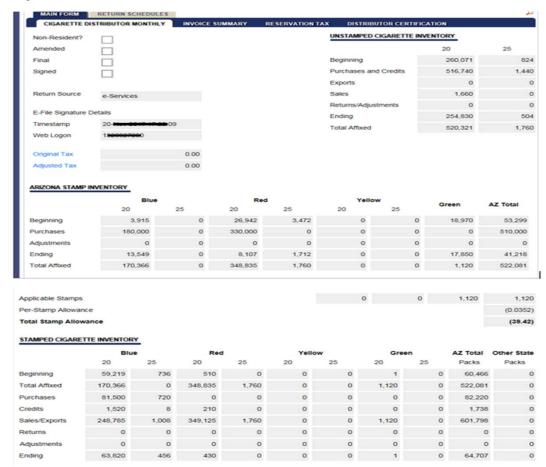
