

Mayor Joe Pizzillo has served on the Goodyear City Council since 2009. During that time, he served as both vice mayor and acting mayor. On Dec. 17, 2021, the Goodyear City Council appointed him to serve as Goodyear's Mayor to complete the term of the late Mayor Georgia Lord. In 2022 he was elected to his own term as Mayor, which began in January 2023.

Mayor Pizzillo brings 30 years of experience in state and local government budgeting and finance to his seat on the council. Prior to his retirement from the city of Goodyear in 2008, he served as the city's Budget Manager.

Currently, he is an adjunct professor of Accounting and Finance with Grand Canyon University, Estrella Mountain Community College, and Park University. He earned his business degree from the University of Maryland and an MBA from the University of Phoenix.

Mayor Pizzillo represents Goodyear on a number of influential committees, including the League of Arizona Cities and Towns Executive Committee, the Maricopa Association of Governments' (MAG) Regional Council, the Greater Phoenix Economic Council (GPEC) Board of Directors, the Southwest Lending Closet Board of Directors, and is an active member of the Pebble Creek Rotary Club.

Mayor Pizzillo and his wife, Vickie, have resided in Goodyear since 2002. They have a son, Nicholas, daughter-in-law Kristen, and two granddaughters, Sophia and Aubrey.
