Director John Greene has extensive public service experience including serving as President of the Arizona State Senate; Chairman of the Arizona State Board of Equalization; Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance; Chief Deputy Treasurer for Maricopa County, Arizona, and as a member of the Arizona Film and Television Advisory Board.



For much of his professional career, John Greene practiced law in the private sector in the areas of federal, state and local taxation; ERISA; administrative law; regulatory compliance; general business law; commercial transactions (including commercial real estate); litigation and government affairs. John is the former chief tax counsel of The Greyhound - Dial Corporation and its worldwide subsidiaries. He also served as in-house tax counsel to New York Life Insurance Company in New York City. John also practiced law with Snell & Wilmer LLP, Tiffany & Bosco, PA and Buchalter Nemer, PLC law firms.

John Greene earned a Bachelor's degree in Political Science from Hunter College of the City University of New York, a Juris Doctor degree from St. John's University, School of Law, where he served as research editor of

the Law Review, and a Master of Laws degree (LL.M.) in taxation, from New York University, School of Law.
