

CORPORATE INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR CONTRIBUTIONS TO SCHOOL TUITION ORGANIZATIONS

REPORTING FOR 2008

Arizona's corporate income tax credit for contributions to school tuition organizations is governed by A.R.S. § 43-1183. School tuition organizations (STOs) must report the following information to the Arizona Department of Revenue by June 30:

1. The name, address and contact name for the STO.
2. The number of contributions received in the previous calendar year.
3. The dollar amount of contributions received in the previous calendar year.
4. The number of children awarded scholarships or grants during the previous calendar year.
5. The dollar amount of scholarships and grants awarded during the previous calendar year.
6. The name and address of each school receiving the scholarships or grant money, along with the number and dollar amount of scholarships or grants provided to each school.
7. Verification that an independent review of financial statements according to generally accepted accounting principals (GAAP) was completed by a certified public accountant for the previous calendar year.

The Arizona Department of Revenue was aware of 55 STOs operating in Arizona in 2008. Fifteen of these STOs received donations in the corporate tuition tax credit program in 2008.¹

DONATIONS BY FISCAL YEAR

Donations to STOs to receive the corporate tuition tax credit are limited by statute. Statutory limitations are by fiscal year. For fiscal year 2007, the limitation was \$10 million. This limitation increases 20% per year².

¹ More restrictive requirements for scholarships recipients of corporate tuition tax credit money and the CPA review may have resulted in the limited participation.

² House Bill 2288, Chapter 168, was signed into law in the first regular session 2009. This legislation removed the original sunset date of June 30, 2011 and allows the credit limitation to continue to grow by 20% annually. It also extended the credit to the insurance premium tax.

The following table shows the amount approved in each fiscal year as opposed to the amount received. It also divides the fiscal year donations into the calendar years in which they were received. Of the \$14.4 million limitation for fiscal year 2009, \$10.8 million was approved and almost \$10.5 million was actually donated.

DONATIONS BY CALENDAR YEAR

For calendar year 2008, \$9,122,121 was donated by 74 corporations⁴ to 15 STOs. Corporate donations ranged from \$200 to over \$1 million. The range of donations made to an STO are shown below:

The Catholic Tuition Support Organization of the Diocese of Tucson received the most donations, 27, for a total of \$2,884,321. Three STOs received only one donation. The smallest donation was \$200,

SCHOLARSHIPS

Corporate credit scholarships are subject to strict guidelines, unlike awards of individual credit scholarship money. Recipients of corporate scholarships must meet the following guidelines:

1. Family income cannot exceed 185% of the income limit required to qualify a child for reduced price lunches under the national school lunch and child nutrition acts. (Maximum annual income of \$72,557 for a family of four for 2008.)
2. The student receiving the scholarship must meet one of the following:
 - a. Attended a governmental primary or secondary school full-time for at least 100 days of the prior fiscal year and then transferred to a qualified private school.

- b. Enroll in a qualified private school in a kindergarten program.
 - c. Received a scholarship under one of the two previous guidelines and continues to attend a qualified private school in a subsequent year.
3. In 2008, a school tuition organization cannot issue a scholarship in an amount that exceeds:
- a. \$4,400 for students in kindergarten through grade 8
 - b. \$5,700 for students in grades 9 through 12.

Nineteen STOs reported scholarships awarded in 2008. These STOs reported 2,967 scholarships totaling \$7,516,750. Shown below is the number of schools receiving scholarships from each STO.

Appendix III, at the end of this report, shows scholarships paid by all STOs for calendar years 2007 and 2008.

As can be seen by the previous table, Arizona School Choice Trust provided scholarships to 99 schools. Five STOs, Arizona Private Education Scholarship Fund, Cheder Scholarship Organization, Children’s Scholarship Network of Arizona, Cochise Christian School Tuition Organization and Maricopa County Schoolhouse Foundation, provided scholarships to only one school. Scholarship money went to 176 schools in 2008, as compared with 156 schools in 2007.

Appendix IV, at the end of this report, shows all schools receiving scholarships out of the corporate tuition tax credit donations

CPA REVIEW

STOs that participate in soliciting corporate contributions are subject to a CPA review that is not required with the individual contributions. On the form on which STOs report the statutorily-required information, there is a place for a certified public accountant to sign, indicating that the required review took place.

The CPA review was reported as complete by most STOs. The remaining STOs reported that their CPA review was in progress or pending.
