# Presentation by Lee Grafstrom, City of Chandler

Mr. Grafstrom representing the City of Glendale on behalf of Linda Willis to propose changes to the Model City Tax Code (MCTC) for consideration by the Municipal Tax Code Commission. In brief, the proposed changes are intended to accomplish the following:

#### A. Section 310, Licensing Effective Upon Glendale City Council approval

Eliminate subsection (j) (The removal is a step in an on-going effort to eliminate as many "green page" items as possible to ensure uniformity and continuity among the cities. A notice has been published on the City's website regarding the proposed change. A notice of public hearing will be held on October 9, 2012 and will be published in the Glendale Star three consecutive weeks.

Question: Diane Landis asked how many groups or companies are affected or impacted by this?

Answer: Approximately 5000 taxpayers are going to be impacted by this change.

Question: Diane Landis asked is the City of Glendale council behind this and are they aware of it?

Answer: Yes, this is a small piece of the proposed ordinance change that the city of Glendale should be considering in October. The ordinance change includes this small item along with all of changes that were made at the last main meeting approved possibly before.
