• Partnerships that **elected to pay tax at the entity level** that had a tax liability of \$500 or more in tax year 2023 are required to pay their tax liability by EFT. Failure to do so shall result in a penalty of 5% of the non-electronic payment.  
• Partnerships that ***did not elect to pay tax at the entity level*** and self-assessed the information return penalty may use this form to submit their payment.

**NOTE:** To avoid interest and penalties, you must pay the full amount of your tax by the due date of your return. You will not receive an additional notice from the Arizona Department of Revenue unless an error exists on your tax return.
