Increase in the amount spent over last year. \$65.1 million was spent in 2018 and \$58.7 million was spent in 2017. Charter holder schools spent more than received but district schools spent less than received.

Historical Contributions: Charter and District Totals


Historical contributions have increased at a rate of 2.3% over 10 years. With spending on programs increasing over contributions received since 2015

Over the last 10 years there has been an average growth rate of 2.3%. In 2015 contributions fell for the first time after remaining flat in the three years prior. Contributions dropped slightly in 2018 down by 1.6% but remain higher than the average of \$50.2 million over the last 10 years.

In calendar years 2015 to 2018 spending has been higher than the amount of contributions received, through the use of unspent monies from prior years. Both charter schools and district schools from 2015 to 2016 spent more than received. In years 2017 and 2018 only charter schools have spent more than received.

In the last five years spending has been higher than the amount received reaching a new high in 2018 as charter holders out spent the amounts of contribution they received by 2:1 , by using unspent monies from prior years.

- \$56,048,449 was reported received in fees or contributions from districts and charter schools ; this is 1.6% less than in 2017 or \$920,499 less than in 2017
- \$65,127,953 was reported as spent.; this is 11% higher or \$6,397,413 more than in 2017
- Schools within districts received 82.9% of the total contribution reported in 2017 and 82.3% of all contributions in 2018.
- Schools within a district spent 76.0% of total spending in 2017 and 68.7% of all spending in 2018
- Schools within charter holders received 17.1% of all contributions in 2017 and 17.7% of all contributions in 2018
- Schools within a charter holder spent 24.0% of total spending in 2017 and 31.3% of all spending in 2018


CHARTER

Charter schools reported receiving \$9,928,869 from 34,692 donors and spending \$20,380,961 in 2018. This is an increase of \$162,479 (or 1.7%) over the \$9,766,389 in fees or cash contributions received in 2017. Spending increased by \$6,257,278 (or 44.3%) over 2017. The amount spent to dollars received was 205.3%. Through the use of unspent monies from prior years.


DISTRICT

District schools reported receiving \$46,119,581 from 257,737 donors and spending \$44,746,992 in 2018. This is a decrease of \$1,082,978 (or 2.3%) over the \$47,202,559 in fees or cash contributions received in 2017. Spending increased slightly by \$140,135 (or 0.3%) over 2017. The amount spent to dollars received was 97.0%.



School Districts




DATA BY DISTRICT AND CHARTER HOLDERS



NUMBER OF DISTRICTS OR HOLDERS WITHIN A RANGE


The chart above shows school districts or charter holders that are grouped within a particular dollar range. Twelve districts reported receiving over \$1 million for a total of \$28,372,546 or 50.6% of all contributions. Likewise, 409 of the 650 districts or charter holders (or 57%) that received at least some contributions in 2018 reported receiving \$50,000 or less. 105 districts or charter holders reported receiving zero dollars. *Reference: Table 2 "Range of Dollars Received"*



THE TOP 15

The top 15 districts out of 225 reported districts accounted for 67.3% of all district contributions received. The top 15 charter holders out of 425 reported charter holders received 30.4% of all charter contributions. Chandler USD (a district) received the highest amount of contributions in 2018 reporting \$5,278,159 in 2018 (or 11.4%). Paragon Management (a charter holder) received the highest amount of contributions \$614,941 (or 6.2%) *Reference: Tables 3 and 4 "Top 15 District or Charter Holder"*


TOP FIVE COUNTIES



Maricopa County received \$39,750,265 (or 71%) from 212,999 donors in 2018; this is a 0.1% increase over 2017 contributions received. Maricopa County received an average of \$187 per donor. Pima County was the second highest receiving \$9,057,169 from 47,040 donors; this is a decrease of 5.8% over 2017. Pima received an average of \$193 per donor. All other counties not listed received a combined total of 5% of all contributions received.


2018 EXPENDITURES BY CATEGORY

TOP 20 SCHOOLS WITHIN A DISTRICT



The top 20 schools within a district received 20.8% of the total contributions received by district schools. The school with the highest contributions received was Catalina Foothills High School in the Catalina Foothills District located in Tucson receiving \$854,714 in contributions. Hamilton High School located in Chandler, was the second highest receiving \$812,877 in contributions.

TOP 20 SCHOOLS WITHIN A CHARTER HOLDER

The top 20 schools within a charter holder received 34.2% of the total contributions received by charter holders. The school with the highest contributions was Paradise Honors Elementary School, a Paragon Management charter holder located in Surprise receiving \$460,007. The second highest was Heritage Academy located in Mesa receiving \$255,234.

POLICY BACKGROUND

STATUTE

Arizona Revised Statute § 43-1089.01 provides a nonrefundable individual income tax credit for fees and cash contributions paid to public schools in Arizona for the support of extracurricular activities, character education programs. The addition of standardized testing fees for college credit or readiness, preparation courses and material for standardized testing or career and technical education industry certification assessment was added in 2015. The addition of cardiopulmonary resuscitations (CPR) training was added in 2016. This credit is only available to individuals.¹ Beginning in 2016, the taxpayer has the option to claim contributions made after December 31 but on or before April 15 on their 2017 return or 2018 return.

CONTRIBUTION LIMITS

The credit is equal to the amount of fees paid, or the amount contributed up to \$200 for single or heads of household taxpayers and up to \$400 for married taxpayers that file a joint return.² The maximum allowable credit of \$200 was increased to \$250 for married taxpayers filing a joint return for taxable year 2001; to \$300 for tax year 2005; and to \$400 for taxable year 2006 and thereafter.

QUALIFYING EXPENDITURES

The school must provide instruction in grades kindergarten through 12. Contributions made or fees paid to a non-governmental school, a pre-school, a community college, a university, or a public school located outside of Arizona does not qualify for this credit. Types of expenditures:

Extracurricular activities

School-sponsored activities that require enrolled students to pay a fee to participate. The activities must supplement the school's education program. Extracurricular activities may include the use of band uniforms, use of equipment or uniforms for varsity athletics, use of scientific laboratory equipment or materials, or in-state or out-of-state trips that are solely for competitive events. Extracurricular activities do not include any senior trips or events that are recreational, amusement or tourist activities.

Character education programs

A program defined in Arizona Revised Statute § 15-719. At a minimum, the character education program must include 1) instruction in the definition and application of at least six of the character traits (truthfulness, responsibility,

compassion, diligence, sincerity, trustworthiness, respect, attentiveness, obedience, orderliness, forgiveness, virtue, fairness, caring, citizenship and integrity), 2) use activities, discussions and presentations to illustrate and reinforce the application of the character traits and 3) presentations by teachers or mentors who demonstrate the character traits.

Standardized testing fees

Testing for college credit or readiness are fees paid to a school for the use of a widely recognized and accepted educational organization such as SAT, PSAT, ACT, advanced placement, international baccalaureate diploma test and other similar tests that are recognized and accepted by colleges and universities in the United States. The fees include preparation courses and materials used for standardized testing.

Career and technical education (CTE) industry certification

CTE assessment are fees paid to a school for career and technical education industry certification assessment. This is an assessment for preparation programs (CTE) that provide students with a pathway to postsecondary education and careers.

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training

The program must be based on the current national emergency CPR guidelines. If this instruction results in a CPR certification, it must be provided by an authorized CPR trainer.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Public Schools must report on a calendar year basis to the Arizona Department of Revenue by February 28 of each year, indicating the total number of donors, the total dollar amount of fees and contributions received and the amount spent by the school. Beginning in 2016, the taxpayer has the option to claim contributions made after December 31 but on or before April 15 in either the previous tax year or in the year the contribution was made. For example, a taxpayer may claim a credit made between January 1 to April 15, 2018, on their 2017 return or 2018 return. However, the public school continues to report contributions on a calendar year basis. The school must also report the amount spent categorized by specific activity or program.

¹ Corporations may not claim this credit. A partnership may not pass the credit through to its partners. An S corporation may not pass the credit through to its shareholders.

² If married taxpayers file separate returns, each spouse may claim only half of the credit that would have been allowed on a joint return.
